Mr. Yamada, executive secretary reported that \$6000.00 worth powdered milk which was previously approved by the committee meeting at \$7000.00 was sent to Japan.

This difference of \$1000.00 was explained by ^Mr. Matsuo, treas. that this difference of \$1000.00 had to be left for covering all expenses for the entertainment. This was approved by the meeting.

Treas. report: Total fund thus far is \$8337.00 \$925.00 tickets were sold (incl. \$128.00 contribution.)

The raffle committee reports: all prizes were donated with \$600.00 cash) The Prizes are television set, typewriter, camera and other 11 prizes. The committee spent \$160.00 for printings and \$60.00 for stamps. They sold \$1603.80(**insix** tickets.
